Gifts to Empower the Treasures

Our **Community Empowerment Program (CEP)** started in 2013 with the inauguration of two Community Centers, which were headquartered in local churches. The program has grown and, in 2015, it will include three Community Centers—the original two and one new located in buildings owned by PHA.

PHA's primary objective is to strengthen its holistic community development model through our Community Centers, with the goal of creating a new community in the area surrounding the garbage dump.

The Centers that are part of the CEP will be focal points for the development of children, youth, and families, where they will be equipped to succeed socially, emotionally, physically, intellectually, and spiritually.

These Centers will offer opportunities for personal development, including education, health, nutrition and entrepreneurship, through an integrated program based on biblical principles.

Through these centers we are empowering the local people to become leaders and serve their community.
